FAQs

Explore Perry during Fiber Flurry, support local businesses, and enter to win a curated prize basket featuring items from participating locations!

When can I participate?

- During Fiber Flurry festival hours:
 - Saturday: 10:00 AM – 4:30 PM
 - Sunday: 10:00 AM – 3:00 PM
- Punches must be collected within these times.

How does it work?

- Visit participating businesses around Perry
 - Receive a passport punch at each location
 - Collect at least 3 punches to be eligible to win
- Submit your completed passport as instructed

Do I need to make a purchase?

- No purchase is necessary to participate
- That being said... we strongly encourage supporting local businesses while you explore!

What can I win?

- One winner will receive a Prize Basket made up of items generously donated by participating businesses

When is the winner selected?

- The drawing will take place at the end of the day on Sunday (3:00 PM) at the Arts Council for Wyoming County
- The winner will be notified by telephone

Is this the same as the Fiber Flurry Door Prize?

- No—there are two separate opportunities to win:
 - Eat, Drink & Be Perry Prize Basket (this program)
 - The Arts Council for Wyoming County's Fiber Flurry Door Prize

To enter the Fiber Flurry door prize, you must:

- Visit the Arts Council for Wyoming County
- Enter that drawing separately

Do all businesses have the same hours?

- No.
- Participating businesses may have their own operating hours, which may differ from festival hours.
- We recommend checking hours in advance when planning your stops.

Who is participating?

- Each participating business:
 - Is independently owned and operated
 - Has generously contributed an item to the prize basket

Additional Rules & Disclaimers

- To ensure a fair and enjoyable experience for everyone:
 - Passports must include at least 3 valid punches to be eligible
 - One entry per person unless otherwise stated
 - Entries must be submitted by the end of the festival on Sunday
 - Winner must be reachable by phone; if not, an alternate winner may be selected
 - Prize is non-transferable and has no cash value

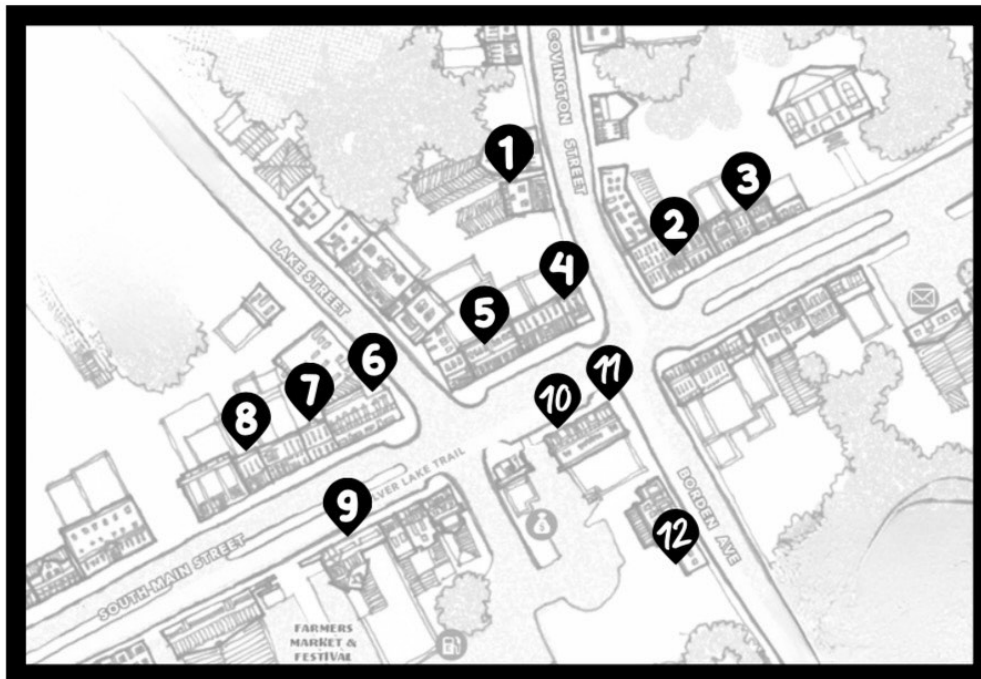
